

CEM351-Honors Option (Fall 2016, Prof. Xuefei Huang)

To get Honors Option credit in CEM351 you need to compose a paper (between 2000 – 3000 words, final paper should be double spaced with no more than 12 pages including figures) on a topic showing how organic chemistry impacts our society and daily lives. Examples presented in the paper must include recent ones from the past two years (i.e., 2015 and 2016). It would be desirable if you can tie in what you have learned from the course.

You can choose your own topic and the topic needs to be approved by me by **Oct. 17th, 2016**.

The final paper is due **Dec. 1st, 2016**. You should email me the final paper before the deadline.

The paper will be graded by me as pass or fail. To receive the honors credit, a student must have a passing mark for the paper and not less than 3.0 for their overall grade point from the class per university rule.
